*Gentiana lutea L.*

- Harvesting time: end summer or autumn
- Uniformity
- Harvesting quota depending on initial plant density, but < 50%
- Cutting and burying shoots
- Adult plants: flowering plants or with many shoots
- Return period: 10-15 years

*Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* (L.) Spreng.

- Harvesting time: autumn
- Harvesting quota: ≤ 50 %
- Only young parts
- Uniformity: the same cover before and after harvesting
- Return period: min. 3 years
